Fraud or Deceptive Acts



Companies generally violate the Washington Consumer Protection Act if they injure your property (e.g., cause you to lose money) through a deceptive business act or practice that might interest other consumers, too. Companies cannot use business acts or practices which can deceive a consumer like you. But some do.
